2017 Legislative Session

In the 2017 session, Senator Rachel Zenzinger sponsored 11 bills, five of which passed into law, and two resolutions. Sen. Zenzinger earned a 100% bipartisan record on all the legislation she carried and passed, with five out of the five bills (100%) earning bipartisan co-sponsors. A majority of the bills sponsored by Sen. Zenzinger focused on education, housing, and the economy.

Prime Sponsor of Senate Bills

<u>SB17-279</u> **Applicability Recent Urban Renewal Legislation:** Concerning clarification of the applicability provisions of recent legislation to promote an equitable financial contribution among affected public bodies in connection with urban redevelopment projects allocating tax revenues.

<u>SB17-144</u> Sunset Review Education Data Advisory Committee: Concerning the recommended continuation of the education data advisory committee by the director of the division of professions and occupations in the department of regulatory agencies.

<u>SB17-123</u> Seal Of Biliteracy For High School Diplomas: Concerning a high school diploma endorsement for biliteracy.

<u>SB17-102</u> Prohibit Use Of Certain Student Personal Information: Concerning prohibitions affecting the student information that school service providers collect. *Postponed Indefinitely.*

<u>SB17-092</u> Immunity Peace Officer Background Checks: Concerning requiring a personnel file waiver for private employment as part of the background check process for a person applying for a position as a peace officer. *Postponed Indefinitely.*

<u>SB17-085</u> Increase Documentary Fee & Fund Attainable Housing: Concerning an increase in the fee imposed by counties in connection with the recording of real estate documents for the purpose of financing a statewide attainable housing investment fund. *Postponed Indefinitely.*

Prime Sponsor of House Bills

<u>HB17-1262</u> **Expand Disclosure Electioneering Communications:** Concerning the expanded disclosure of electioneering communications to include the period between the primary election and the general election. *Postponed Indefinitely.*

<u>HB17-1261</u> **Disclaimers Large Electioneering Communications:** Concerning disclaimer requirements applicable to large electioneering communications. *Postponed Indefinitely.*

<u>HB17-1201</u> Science Technology Engineering Math Diploma Endorsement: Concerning authorization for granting a high school diploma endorsement in the combined disciplines of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

<u>HB17-1038</u> **Prohibit Corporal Punishment Of Children:** Concerning prohibiting corporal punishment of children in certain public settings. *Postponed Indefinitely.*

HB17-1016 Exclude Value Mineral Resources Tax Increment Financing Division:

Concerning the ability of an urban renewal authority to exclude the valuation attributable to the extraction of mineral resources located within an urban renewal area from the total amount of taxable property subject to division for the purpose of financing urban renewal projects.
