# 2018 Legislative Session

In the 2018 session, Senator Rachel Zenzinger sponsored 25 bills, 22 of which passed into law, and one resolution. Sen. Zenzinger earned a 100% bipartisan record on all the legislation she carried and passed, with all 22 bills (100%) earning bipartisan co-sponsors. A majority of the bills sponsored by Sen. Zenzinger focused on education, transportation, and measures to make government more efficient.

#### **Prime Sponsor of Senate Bills**

<u>SB18-189</u> Alcohol Beverage Service Special Events: Concerning the ability of certain organizations conducting a special event to sell alcohol beverages for fundraising purposes under specified circumstances.

<u>SB18-159</u> Innovation School Operating As A Community School: Concerning permitting a public school to include operation as a community school in its innovation plan. *Postponed Indefinitely.* 

<u>SB18-147</u> **Educator Loan Forgiveness Program:** Concerning the educator loan forgiveness program to address educator shortages. *Postponed Indefinitely.* 

<u>SB18-107</u> Repeal Nomination Vacancy Filling In Municipal Elections: Concerning the repeal of procedures to fill vacancies in candidate nominations for elections conducted under the "Colorado Municipal Code of 1965".

<u>SB18-102</u> Odometer Reading Physical Vehicle Identification Number Verification: Concerning the requirement for an odometer reading when a motor vehicle's identification number is physically verified.

<u>SB18-098</u> Unconstitutional Language Interest On Damages: Concerning amending a statutory provision relating to interest on damages that was ruled unconstitutional by the Colorado supreme court.

<u>SB18-095</u> Outdated References To "Illegitimate" Children: Concerning the removal of statutory references to the marital status of parents of a child.

<u>SB18-090</u> Terminology Referencing "Rights Of Married Women": Concerning "rights of married women".

<u>SB18-082</u> Physician Non Compete Exemption For Rare Disorder: Concerning a physician's right to provide continuing care to patients with rare disorders despite a covenant not to compete.

<u>SB18-067</u> Auction Alcohol In Sealed Container Special Events: Concerning the ability of certain organizations conducting a special event to auction alcohol beverages in sealed containers for fundraising purposes under specified circumstances.

<u>SB18-069</u> Enforcement Statewide Degree Transfer Agreements: Concerning enforcement of statewide degree transfer agreements.

<u>SB18-006</u> **Recording Fee To Fund Attainable Housing:** Concerning the ability of the counties to increase the fee they charge for the recording of real estate documents for the purpose of financing a statewide attainable housing investment fund. *Postponed Indefinitely.*

<u>HB18-1413</u> Create School Safety Grant Program: Concerning the creation of a school safety grant program, and, in connection therewith, making an appropriation.

<u>HB18-1364</u> **Sunset Colorado Council Persons With Disabilities:** Concerning the continuation of the Colorado advisory council for persons with disabilities, and, in connection therewith, implementing the sunset review recommendations of the department of regulatory agencies, and making an appropriation.

<u>HB18-1354</u> **Powersports Vehicle Written Warranties:** Concerning a requirement that written warranties for powersports vehicles be honored.

<u>HB18-1299</u> Electronic Filing Title Registration Motor Vehicle: Concerning electronic documents related to the ownership of a vehicle that is regulated by the department of revenue, and, in connection therewith, making an appropriation.

<u>HB18-1138</u> **Public Official Oaths And Affirmations:** Concerning standardizing public official oaths of office, and, in connection therewith, providing a uniform oath text and establishing requirements for taking, subscribing, administering, and filing public oaths of office.

<u>HB18-1137</u> Reporting Requirements Department Of Transportation And Department Of Public Safety To General Assembly: Concerning the scheduled repeal of reports to the

general assembly, and, in connection therewith, continuing the requirements for reports by the department of transportation and the department of public safety.

<u>HB18-1193</u> Extend Advanced Placement Incentives Program: Concerning the advanced placement incentives pilot program, and, in connection therewith, making an appropriation.

<u>HB18-1142</u> Remove Term "Pauper" From Colorado Revised Statutes: Concerning modernizing language in statutory sections that refer to paupers.

<u>HB18-1141</u> **Modernize Early Childhood Council Language:** Concerning the removal of outdated references in statute to "early childhood care and education councils".

<u>HB18-1139</u> Reporting Requirements For Park Fees Set By Rule: Concerning the removal of outdated statutory references to repealed reporting requirements that were previously imposed on the parks and wildlife commission with regard to its rule-making authority to set fees.

<u>HB18-1070</u> Additional Public School Capital Construction Funding: Concerning an increase in the amount of financial assistance that can be provided for public school capital construction under the "Building Excellent Schools Today Act", and, in connection therewith, increasing the amount of retail marijuana excise tax revenue that is credited to the public school capital construction assistance fund and making an appropriation.

<u>HB18-1042</u> **Private Interstate Commercial Vehicle Registration:** Concerning the creation of a program to authorize private providers to register commercial vehicles as Class A personal property, and, in connection therewith, making and reducing an appropriation.

<u>HB18-1018</u> **Human Trafficking Commercial Driver's License:** Concerning a requirement that education to prevent human trafficking be included in the training to obtain a commercial driver's license.
